Set between Rinca and Komodo, Padar Island offers one of the most picturesque anchorages in the region. Surrounded by towering peaks and nutrient-rich waters, it's a prime spot for snorkeling, watersports, or simply soaking in the dramatic landscape. Take a tender cruise into the mangroves for a closer view of nature.

Day 9: Rinca Island – Komodo Dragon Exploration

Rinca Island, less frequented but equally captivating, provides an excellent opportunity to observe the famed Komodo dragons in their natural habitat. Accompanied by a park ranger, you'll explore the island and spot other wildlife, including monkeys and rare birds. The afternoon offers more chances to dive or snorkel.

Day 10: Sebayor Island Castaway Day

At Sebayor Island, spend a relaxing day on deserted beaches backed by the dramatic hills of Komodo. Dive with black-tip reef sharks, spot green turtles, or simply enjoy the peaceful surroundings. The day concludes with cocktails and dinner as you admire one final spectacular sunset.
