# Raja Ampat Archipelago

Raja Ampat, situated off the northwest tip of the Bird's Head Peninsula in West Papua, is often hailed as one of the most remarkable environments on Earth.

Its main islands—Misool, Batanta, Waigeo, and Salawati—are surrounded by a labyrinth of 1,500 smaller islands, offering pristine beaches and dramatic limestone cliffs that plunge into crystalclear waters. Adventurous visitors can explore the jungles to spot rare bird species or visit remote villages to experience local traditions.

# Day 1: Sorong

Settle in as you embark on the journey to the breathtaking islands of Raja Ampat. #### Days 2, 3 & 4: Misool

Wake up to a serene pastel sunrise as you arrive at the southeastern edge of Misool. Over the next three days, you'll explore this enchanting region, home to a maze of islands with hidden lagoons, dramatic cliffs, and pristine beaches. Dive and snorkel in world-renowned spots like Boo Windows and Magic Mountain, and marvel at the ethereal beauty of the "Gua Sacral" caves. Visit the nearby pearl farm to learn about the locals' traditional craft, and claim a secluded beach for an unforgettable picnic.

# Day 5: Penemu

The Penemu Islands feature lush limestone domes that rise from turquoise waters. A short hike will take you to a stunning lookout point, offering panoramic views of the surrounding lagoon. Spend the day diving or snorkeling among intricate coral gardens where you may encounter turtles and manta rays, set against the backdrop of nutrient-rich waters teeming with marine life.

## Day 6: The Passage

Begin your day at dawn with a jungle hike in search of the elusive Red Bird of Paradise. After breakfast, explore the towering mushroom-shaped islands of Kabui Bay and navigate through the narrow, current-swept water channels known as The Passage, where coral and fish abound in this unique saltwater river.

# Days 7 & 8: Wayag

The islands of Wayag offer some of the most breathtaking views in all of Raja Ampat. Spend two days exploring this tropical paradise, with opportunities for water sports, beach time, and exploration. Climb to the top of an island peak for panoramic views of turquoise waters, or relax on a deserted beach as the sun sets. Enjoy gourmet meals prepared by your private chef, creating an unforgettable experience.

## Day 9: Wofoh

Explore the shallow reef that connects two islands at Wofoh, ideal for beachcombing, paddleboarding, or kayaking. The island's coral walls are some of the most beautiful in the region, dropping into deep blue waters filled with vibrant marine life, including surgeonfish, barracuda, and the elusive unicorn fish.

### Day 10: Kri Peninsula

Start the day with the sounds of tropical birds in Mioskon Bay, a perfect location for snorkeling in the mangroves or kayaking along the coastline. The Kri Peninsula offers spectacular underwater vistas with its abundant fish and coral slopes. In the afternoon, visit the island of Mansuar, where you can explore a local village and experience the culture of Raja Ampat.

### Day 11: Batanta

Today, head to the waters near Arborek Island, where you'll snorkel or dive in search of manta rays gliding through the currents. In the afternoon, explore Arborek village, where the local communities engage in sustainable fishing and pearl farming. Experience the warmth of the local culture before returning to the yacht for your final dinner onboard.

### Day 12: Sorong
