Komodo National Park

Situated east of Bali and Lombok, Komodo National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the renowned home of the iconic Komodo dragon. It is also one of Indonesia's most coveted cruising destinations.

To the east of Bali, the islands of Lombok, Sumbawa, Moyo, and Flores offer a rich array of on-land experiences. The legendary Komodo dragons of Komodo National Park, steeped in local mythology, are believed to be descendants of a dragon princess from centuries past.

In the north, rolling hills and dense mangroves give way to rugged mountains in the park's central region. To the south, Horseshoe Bay evokes images of Jurassic Park with its towering cliffs often cloaked in mist and the powerful waves of the Pacific crashing against the shoreline.

The warm, tropical waters of Komodo National Park are among the most biodiverse on the planet, home to over 1,000 species of fish and 260 types of coral. What makes this underwater wonderland even more enticing is that approximately 60% of its dive sites are also perfect for snorkeling, thanks to the shallow reefs. For surfers, the nearby islands of Lombok, Sumbawa, Sumba, and Rote offer world-class waves.

Day 1: Labuan Bajo – Kanawa – Sebayur Kecil

Your journey begins as you arrive in Labuan Bajo, where our friendly staff will greet you at the airport and accompany you to your luxurious yacht, docked just 20 minutes away. Once on board, you'll be welcomed by the Cruise Director and treated to a delectable meal prepared by our private chef. Set sail toward Kanawa Island, where the afternoon can be spent relaxing on white sandy beaches, snorkeling in the vibrant turquoise waters, or exploring the teeming coral reefs. Keep an eye out for playful dolphins swimming alongside the yacht.

As the day winds down, we'll cruise toward Sebayur Kecil for a short hike, offering panoramic views of the surrounding islands and a mesmerizing sunset to finish your first day.

Day 2: Komodo Island – Karang Makassar (Manta Point)

Today brings you face-to-face with the legendary Komodo dragons. After an early start, meet your ranger at Soro Liah station for a guided trek through Komodo National Park. Along the way, spot wild deer and buffalo as you follow the trails in search of the iconic Komodo dragons in their natural habitat.

Following a sumptuous lunch on board, sail to the famous Pink Beach, where you can snorkel or dive into the colorful underwater world teeming with marine life. Expect to encounter blue ribbon eels, crocodile fish, and fascinating coral canyons. As the day comes to an end, indulge in a sunset beach BBQ prepared by our crew, while you watch the stars light up the sky.

Day 3: Padar Island – Nusa Kode – Siaba Besar

Wake up to breathtaking views of Padar Island, where a morning hike to the summit rewards you with panoramic views of the island's four unique bays. Resident wildlife, such as sea eagles and deer, can often be seen as you explore the island.

For those who prefer underwater adventures, Pillarsteen offers impressive pinnacles covered in soft corals, caves, and swim-throughs. Afterward, sail toward the west coast of Rinca Island and explore Mauan's reef, known for its abundance of sea turtles and occasional manta ray cleaning stations. The day ends in Siaba Besar Bay, surrounded by tranquil mangroves, with a spectacular private beach BBQ awaiting your arrival.

Day 4: Kelor Island – Labuan Bajo

On the final morning, you'll wake up anchored near the picturesque Kelor Island, where you can enjoy a hearty breakfast on deck. Before returning to the harbor, there will be one last opportunity for exploration or relaxation. After a leisurely lunch on board, bid farewell to your crew as you disembark and are escorted to the airport for your onward journey, completing your unforgettable voyage with The Luxury Voyage.
