Alor Archipelago

Today, the islands retain a strong sense of tradition and are home to highland villages with deep-rooted customs and fascinating history.

Visitors to Alor will be warmly welcomed by the locals, and the area offers a mix of cultural immersion and natural beauty. The region is also excellent for diving, with clear waters that boast rich marine life, including pelagic fish like hammerhead sharks. Whether exploring vibrant reefs or visiting traditional villages, Alor promises an unforgettable experience for adventurers.

Day 1: Maumere

Upon your arrival at Maumere airport, you'll be warmly welcomed by The Luxury Voyage crew and transferred to the harbor. Once settled onboard, the yacht will set sail. Spend a leisurely afternoon exploring the pristine beaches of Maumere Bay or taking your first dive or snorkel in the vibrant underwater world of Alor. End the day with a sunset cocktail as you cruise into the night.

Day 2: Palo

Today, you'll approach the small volcanic island of Palo. Ashore, you'll find a village perched on the volcanic slopes, seemingly unfazed by the smoking crater above. Explore the traditional weaving of ikat textiles in the village, then enjoy lunch onboard before an afternoon of snorkeling and diving in the crystal-clear waters. The yacht will sail in the evening for an overnight crossing to Kawula.

Day 3: Kawula & Komba

In the morning, dive along the north coast of Kawula, where schools of reef fish gather around tiers of hard coral beneath the shadow of the Ile Ape volcano. You can also visit the village of lonata to see the impressive skeleton of a blue whale. If weather permits, the yacht will cross to Komba, where you can witness the dramatic sight of an active volcano spewing smoke into the sky.

Day 4: Takpala & Mombang

Today, visit the traditional Abui tribe villages of Takpala and Mombang, situated on a hill with spectacular views of the Flores Sea. These villages are home to stilted huts made from timber and bamboo, where you can witness the local people's rich cultural heritage. Watch the traditional Lego-lego dance, used to mark important events like harvests and weddings, and observe the women crafting clothing from tree bark using ancient techniques.

Day 5: Pura Island

Pura Island, a small village in the heart of the Alor Strait, serves as a gateway to some of the region's most stunning diving and snorkeling sites. Spend the day exploring underwater marvels such as Clown Valley, Sharks Galore, Mandarin House, and The Boardroom, where vibrant reefs and diverse marine life await.

Day 6: Pantar Strait

A thrilling day of underwater exploration awaits in the Pantar Strait, one of the few channels between Sumatra and Timor where Pacific waters flow into the Indian Ocean. The currents here attract prolific marine life, including large pelagic species. In the evening, anchor at the entrance to Kalabahi Bay, home to Mucky Mosque, one of the best critter night dives in the region.

Day 7: Beangabang

In the far south of the Pantar Strait lies the remote village of Beangabang, set on a beautiful bay surrounded by headlands. The black sands and evidence of the island's volcanic past make this an extraordinary place to visit. Even by local standards, the village is simple but full of welcoming people, offering a wonderful opportunity to experience local culture.

Day 8: Alor

On the final morning, the yacht will arrive at Alor port. After a sumptuous breakfast on deck, your crew will assist with your disembarkation and transfer to the airport, marking the end of your unforgettable Luxury Voyage through the Alor Archipelago.
